

Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST) is for anyone 16 or older—regardless of prior experience—who wants to provide suicide first aid. ASIST teaches effective intervention skills, helps build suicide prevention networks in the community, and major studies have shown it to significantly reduce thoughts of suicide and suicide attempts.

Participants must attend <u>both full days</u> in a session to receive certification. All trainings are 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.
