Tax Foreclosure Deadline Moved to May 29th

Treasurer Meisner is reminding taxpayers that the March 31st deadline to pay your property taxes from tax year 2017 and prior has been extended to **May 29, 2020** by Executive Order of the Governor and by an earlier mandate issued by Treasurer Meisner that **no property in Oakland County would be lost because of hardship associated with the Coronavirus crisis.**
