

New grant program to aid in the control and eradication of aquatic invasive plants in Michigan's inland lakes

There is a new funding opportunity for managing invasive species in inland lakes. For this year, only permit fees are eligible. The work done under the permit must be invasive removal only, no management of native species is allowed.

Eligible organizations to apply are lake associations, non-profits, property owner's association, homeowner's association, lake board or special assessment district. Applications are due by July 1st.
