### **2018 Backyard Habitat Program**

For property owners who would like to learn from a local organization how to develop a backyard habitat for wildlife. The Oakland Conservation District is a locally led organization of state government with guidance from USDA. The District has a variety of resources to help local property owners in developing their backyard habitat. To create the best habitat it is necessary to have knowledge of their property's soil. From this, you will then identify the plants that will enable the proper habitat for the wildlife you want in your backyard. You'll also learn to identify potentially harmful invasive plants/species.

**Once the program is completed you will receive a sign promoting your successful certification,  
which is good for five years.**

The entire course is only \$75 and includes a personal consultation, comprehensive workbook, and a soil survey.


You must bring a laptop or tablet to each session.


